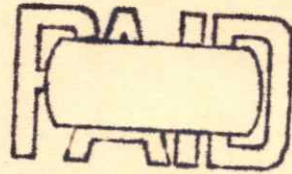

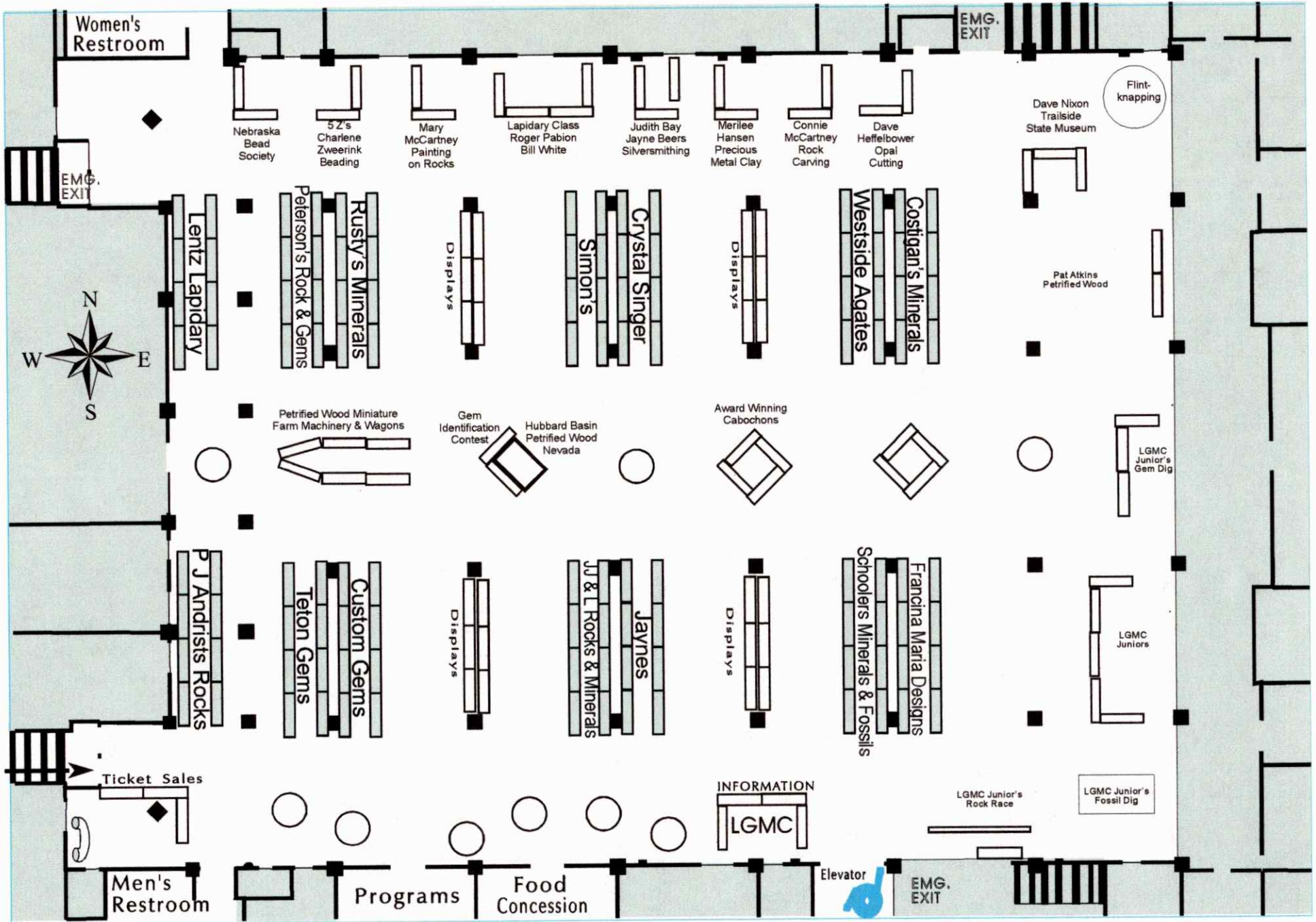
Setup - Instructions
