What are Thundereggs?

Thundereggs are a special kind of agate nodule that occur only in rhyolite, perlite or obsidian. They are found in many locations worldwide, but the greatest variety, perhaps 100 kinds, is in Oregon, where it is the state stone. Thundereggs have lumpy outer surfaces that sometimes display protrusions like the stitches in a baseball. When cut properly, a thunderegg may reveal an agate, opal or geode core in the shape of a square, maple leaf, star, fish or butterfly. Thunderegg varieties are identified by characteristics of their outer surface, inner matrix and agate core.

What's the difference between a thunderegg and a geode?

A geode is a hollow nodule, often lined with crystals. A thunderegg can be a geode, but not all geodes are thundereggs. For example, Mexican Las Choyas "Coconut" Geodes, and sedimentary geodes from Brown County, Indiana; Keokuk, Iowa; and Kentucky are not thundereggs, while so-called "Dugway Geodes" from Utah and Mexican Zacatecas Geodes are actually thundereggs. Therefore, thunderegg expert John Stockton of Berkeley, California, suggests they be called "thunderegg geodes."

How are thundereggs formed?

Thundereggs differ from amygdaloidal, sedimentary and vein agates, but are like them in that their exact mechanism of formation is not clear. Paul "Geode Kid" Colburn of Deming, New Mexico, has studied thundereggs and analyzed their formation for 60 years. He notes that as the viscous rhyolite lava cools, centers of spherulitic crystallization form. In cooling, their interiors split along regular planes, forming a pyritohedron-

-shaped cavity that is later filled with agate, opal or quartz. If the rhyolitic matrix weathers away, a core remains.

What's the origin of the term "thunderegg"?

According to a legend of the Warm Springs Indians of Central Oregon, thunder gods living on adjacent volcanoes, Mt. Jefferson and Mt. Hood, stole eggs out of the nests of thunderbirds and threw them at each other. Some of the eggs missed their mark and landed on the ground. These were called "thundereggs."

In Europe and in scientific literature, thundereggs are often referred to as "lithophysae," meaning rock bubbles. Some German collectors have adopted the term "donner-ei" which is German for thunderegg.

Are thundereggs important?

That depends upon whom you ask. Thundereggs have long been the ugly cousins of the agate world, but now are becoming more valuable in the lapidary world as collectable specimens and cutting materials. Some varieties of thundereggs have cores of precious opal or plume agate that are highly prized. For example, top-grade opal-filled Ethiopian thundereggs are sold by the gram. Colorful plume agate from the cores of Friday Ranch Flowerbasket Bed thundereggs is exceedingly rare and valuable. The rock at Yucca Mountain, Nevada, where the national nuclear waste repository is to be located, is lithophysal (thunderegg-bearing) rhyolite. Thundereggs are artifacts of violent eruptions, like that of Mount St. Helens. Unlike runny basalt lava, viscous high-silica lava is similar in consistency to peanut butter. Goopy rhyolite lavas may form domes or bulges. When sufficient pressure has built up, eruptions can be explosive.

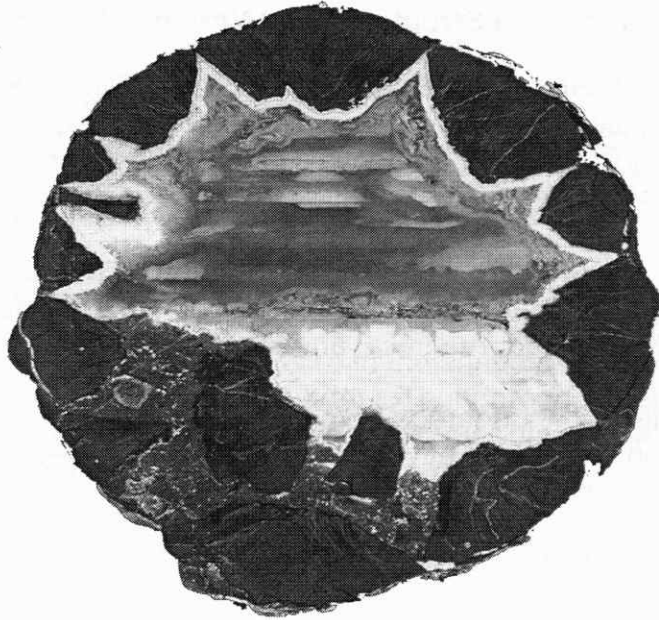
- Thunderegg agate cores from Cibuk, Turkey; St. Egidien, Germany; Lucky Strike Mine, Oregon; Burugdi Mountain, Mongolia, Harvey Gap-Killer Green claim, Oregon, McDermitt, Oregon.
- Thunderegg “conglomerate” - primordial thundereggs in matrix from Nesselhof, Thuringia, Germany Queensland, Australia, and Madras, Oregon.
- Flat bed thunderegg from Buchanan Ranch, Oregon. The depth at which these are found seems to account for the flattened shape.
- Torpedo thunderegg from Oregon.
- Chalcedony stalactite structures in an Oregon thunderegg. These give credence to the theory that the silica was in a gel state when it entered the cavity.
- Horizontal “tilt” banding Slumping or faulting during deposition of the “water-level” banding resulted in different angled levels.
- “Slip” thunderegg in which the halves are offset.

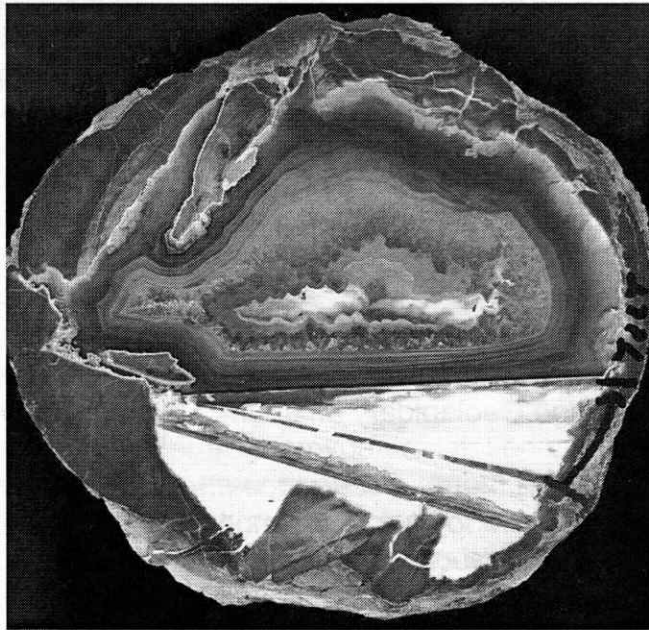

For adult tastes, one will be able to find where to go to learn such artistic skills as metalwork-

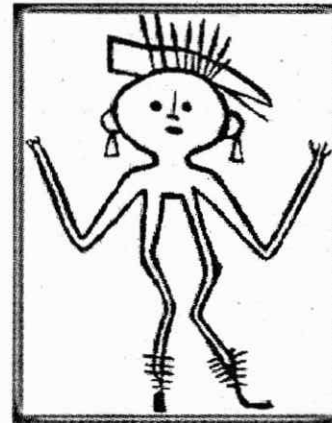
ing and gem cutting.




