


GRAN PREMIO PETROGRAFICA (ROCK RACES)

And they're off and running.....

Is it a new olympic sport? Is it a new way of setting your pet rock in shape? Is it a way of setting on "That's Incredible"? Whatever it is, we are looking for the fastest rock in the world. We will start our search at the Lincoln Gem and Mineral Club's 26th Annual Show, March 31, and April 1, 1984, at the Agricultural Hall, State Fairgrounds, Lincoln. Track hours are from 9 to 9 on Saturday and 9 to 5 on Sunday.

OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. Rocks must pass a U.S. Standard 1.50" square screen opening and be retained on a U.S. Standard 0.50" square screen opening.
- 2. Two rocks will race at one time in a match race. The first rock to complete the course will be declared winner and will advance to the next heat. Losing rock will go to loser's bracket where it will race against other rocks in the loser's bracket. Upon losing two races, a rock will be disqualified from further competition. Finalists will race in double eliminations. Winners in all classes will be awarded trophies.
- 3. To be declared a winner, a rock must complete the distance of and stay on the prescribed course, which is a 3'9" drop over a distance of 16'4". (See diagram.) Rocks which do not complete the course or which go off of the course will be considered mechanically deficient or safety hazards and will be excluded from further competition.
- 4. All rocks must be their natural state, having no laridary treatment or other modifications.
- 5. Only one rock per entrant per race. Individuals may enter as many rocks as desired; however, an indivudual must so to the end of the racins order after each race, and a separate indivudual entry fee must be paid for each rock entered. Individual contestants must be present at the show site to be elegible to enter rocks in races.
- 6. Club entries may be sent in by U.S. Mail or other common carrier. Only winning club entries and their respective trophies will be returned. The Lincoln Gem and Mineral Club, being host society, is inelegible to compete in the Club Class.
- 7. Contestants are expected to enter rocks that are fully trained for the risors of racins. The use of anabolic steroids in preconditioning your rock or the use of various "pep" drugs on rocks prior to the race is strictly prohibited. Rocks will be randomly tested for drugs and violators will be dealt with accordingly.

All proceeds from the "Gran Premio Petrografica" will go to the scholarship fund.
