

WIRE WRAP CLASS BY NYKKY

The last wire wrap/weaving class taught by Nykky of Nykky Little Chrystal was held on March 14 at Hidden Gems by The Jewelry Connection. The lesson was wrapping a teardrop or elongated cabochon. This lesson, for the first time, was live stream projected onto the large TV in the classroom. It was quite helpful for everyone to see each step in the project.

For those who don't know, Nykky's main medium is copper wire. It is easy to work with and relatively inexpensive for newbies.

Nykky's next class will be April 25 at Hidden Gems. The lesson will be on wire wrapping a long, narrow crystal, in this case, kunzite.
